RE: DMCA notice for removal of copyrighted material

My name is Daniel Sanders I am the duly authorized representative of the exclusive rights holder for the Virtual Live Streamer "Ironmouse." Your website is infringing on at least one copyright owned by my client.

A video recording was copied onto your servers without permission. The video, to which my client owns the exclusive copyrights to, was originally uploaded on a younow page which has since been deleted at the behest of the copyright holder.

This letter is official notification under Section 512(c) of the Digital Millennium Copyright Act ("DMCA"), and I seek the removal of the aforementioned infringing material from your servers.

Please also be advised that law requires you, as a service provider, to remove or disable access to the infringing materials upon receiving this notice. Under US law a service provider, such as yourself, enjoys immunity from a copyright lawsuit provided that you act with deliberate speed to investigate and rectify ongoing copyright infringement. If service providers do not investigate and remove or disable the infringing material, this immunity is lost. Therefore, in order for you to remain immune from a copyright infringement action you will need to investigate and ultimately remove or otherwise disable the infringing material from your servers with all due speed should the direct infringer, your client, not comply immediately. Additionally, should you fail to remove the aforementioned infringing material, you may also be subject to statutory damages for willful infringement of up to \$150,000 per instance of infringement.

I am providing this notice in good faith and with the reasonable belief that the rights my client owns are being infringed. Under penalty of perjury I certify that the information contained in the notification is both true and accurate, and I have the authority to act on behalf of the owner of the copyright involved.
